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

CONTEST MECHANICS 3rd Inter- High School Economics Quiz Bee Competition

I. GENERAL RULES

- 1. The 3rd Inter-High School Economics Quiz Bee is an individual competition.
- 2. Each school shall send two (2) contestants for this competition who will be competing individually.
- 3. There are four (4) rounds in the competition namely: Easy, Average, Difficult and Clincher. The Clincher round takes place only if there is a tie.
- 4. The questions for the entire competition will cover the field of Economics particularly on Microeconomics with highlights on current events, central banking and monetary policies.
- 5. The questions are formulated by the staff of the Economic and Financial Learning Center of BSP Dumaguete Branch. Questions vary from each round either conceptual and/or computational type.
- 6. The Coach shall be duly endorsed by the participating school and shall occupy a seat in the Coach area during the competition proper.
- 7. The Quiz Bee will be in English language.
- 8. The venue of the competition is at Bangko Sentral ng Pilipinas (BSP) Dumaguete Branch, North National Highway, Daro, Dumaguete City. All contestants should be in the venue at least 30-minutes before the scheduled time. The competition will start at exactly 1:00 o'clock in the afternoon on July 28, 2016.
- Clarifications regarding the rules of the competition shall be entertained by the Committee before the start of the Contest.
- 10. There shall be an elimination round that will last for 30 minutes thru paper and pen for a maximum of 50 questions at 1 point each. Only the Top 15 contestants shall qualify to the next rounds.

II. QUALIFICATIONS

- 1. All bonafide high school students (Junior or Senior High School) preferably those who have taken or still taking up Economics subject(s) from any public or private schools in the Province of Negros Oriental may join the contest.
- 2. Deadline for the submission of application to join the competition shall be on or before July 25, 2016.
- 3. The Coach shall be a teacher from the participating school and shall be duly endorsed in writing by the school Principal as the official coach for the team. The endorsement letter shall be attached to the application form.

III. ROUNDS

- 1. All contestants will answer the same set of questions in writing. Before a question is read, the contestants must raise their illustration boards and markers.
- 2. Questions will be read twice by the Quizmaster.
- 3. After the second (2nd) reading, the Quizmaster shall say "GO" --- only then will the contestants be allowed to write their answer. The time limit for each round are as follows:

Easy Round - 15 seconds
Average Round - 30 second
Difficult Round - 45 seconds
Clincher Round - 1 minute

- 4. Automatically, the time limit will begin with the word "GO" by the Quizmaster. After the time limit and the buzzer or bell sounds, the contestants must stop writing and the contestants shall raise their illustration board.
- 5. The Quizmaster shall read and verify the contestants' answers.
- 6. There are four (4) rounds in the competition namely: Easy, Average, Difficult and Clincher. The Clincher round takes place only if there is a tie.
- 7. Points are assigned for each question being answered correctly:

Easy Round

1 point

Average Round Difficult Round

2 points

Clincher Round

3 points

5 points

8. There are specific number of questions per round as follows:

Easy Round

10 auestions

Average Round

10 questions

Difficult Round

5 questions

- 9. After the fifth (5th) question in the Difficult Round, the total number of points of each contestant is tabulated.
- 10. The contestant who gets the highest number of points is automatically declared the Champion; and the second (2nd) highest --- the Runner - up.
- 11. Should there be a tie among the contestants getting the highest score or the second (2nd) highest score, the contest continues to the Clincher Round to determine the Champion or the Runner - up as the case may be.
- 12. The total number of points of the tied contestants will revert back to zero (0).
- 13. In the Clincher Round, as many questions will be asked. Each question is assigned five (5) points. The contestant who first (1st) gets fifteen (15) points is declared the Winner.
- 14. Should another tie occur after the third (3rd) Clincher question, one (1) more question will be asked to break the tie and so on until a Winner is declared.
- 15. All answers with incorrect spellings are considered wrong and therefore have no equivalent points.
- 16. Misbehavior of a contestant or team during the competition, as determined by the Board of Judges, is a sufficient condition for disqualification.
- 17. No questions shall be entertained during the contest proper.
- 18. The duly registered teacher coach of the contestants is the only person authorized to make a protest.
- 19. All protest should be referred to the Board of Judges immediately, before the Quizmaster reads the next question.
- 20. The Board of Judges shall be in complete control of the contest. Their decision shall be final in all questions/protests.
