#### General Guidelines

- 1. Student participants will wear their school uniform on the first day of the congress.
- 2. Each school will bring their SCHOOL BANNER to be used during the opening program.
- 3. Each participant should bring 2x2 recent colored picture for the Congress ID.
- 4. Each participant should bring his/her school identification (ID) card.
- 5. Each participant should submit the parent's/guardian's waiver to his/her respective school.
- A student is allowed to join in ONE contest only except for ZUMBA Competition which will be held on the morning of the second day. Failure to do so is a ground for disqualification.
- Venues for simultaneous eliminations for the different contests (on the first day) will be announced during the opening ceremony.
- The participant should be a bona fide student and currently enrolled in a private school registered under the PRISSAAP School Year 2016-2017.
- 9. The student should be a registered participant of the Youth Congress.
- 10. Ranking system abould be used in identifying the winner of every contest. In case of a tie, the chief judge has the right to break the tie.
- Always follow the rules and mechanics of the different contests. Failure to observe the said rules and mechanics is a ground for disqualification.

#### **Dance Fitness Competition**

- 1. There should only be one competing group per school.
- 2. The group is composed of 20-25 students per school, either all males or females or mix.
- 3. The students composing the group should be a registered participants of the 14<sup>a</sup> National Youth Congress.
- 4. The teacher chaperon, trainer, dance/Zumba master and/or adviser are not allowed to join the group.
- 5. The participants should wear appropriate Zumba attire
- 6. The music should not be less than 2 minutes and not more than 3 minutes. One (1) point will be deducted from every judge's total score for every 30 seconds less and/or 30 seconds exceeding the time limit.
- 7. The music can either be one entire song or mix.
- 8. The music should be ready 10 minutes before the performance.
- 9. The music must be accurately cued up for playing.
- 10. The music could either be in cellphone, ipad, or tab copy. No USB or CD copy.
- 11. No props allowed.
- 12. The participants should be present 20 minutes before the contest for briefing and instructions.
- Drawing of lots will be done a day before the Zumba and to be announced during the congress.
- 14. The decision of the judges is final and irrevocable.

- 1. Only one (1) group participant coming from each school. The group is composed of minimum of fifteen (15) and a maximum of twenty five (25) members, either all males, all females of mix.
- The group will undergo an elimination round to qualify them in the final round.
   For the elimination round, the group is going to sing the whole song. Only five (5) groups will qualify in the final round.
- For the Final round, the piece must be a composition of a Filipino composer in Filipino or English. A hard copy of the lyrics of the song (3 copies, short sized bond paper) should be submitted to the committee an hour before the contest.
- The group must be accompanied by a CD or any musical instrument/accompaniment to be used during the performance. Videoke, multiplex, USB, tablet, cell phone downloaded copy is not allowed.
- 5. A cappella singing is allowed.
- 6. There shall be no time limit in the performance.
- 7. The decision of the board of judges is final.

#### Dance Sports

- 1. There will be one couple (male and female) coming from each school.
- The participant will undergo an elimination round to qualify them in the final round. Only five (5) pairs will qualify in the final round.
- During the elimination round, the partner will render their dance using their choice of songs. A CD
  copy of the music for the dance entry should be submitted before the performance. USB, tablet or cell
  phone copy is not allowed.
- 4. Latin American is the category of the competition which is composed of:
  - a. Cha cha cha
- c. Rhumba

c. Jive

- b. Samba
- d, Paso Doble
- Each dance must be executed in one and half (1 ½) minutes except for jive which must be executed in minimum of one (1) minute.
- 6. Use of religious symbols as decoration or jewelry is not allowed.
- A couple who bumps into another couple or stumble down during the competition will be disqualified in the contest.
- 8. The line direction should be followed during the competition especially in Samba.
- The judging of the couple begins when they adopt their dancing position and ends only when the music stops. The judges must only check their marks during the entire dance and amend them if necessary.
- 10. If the couple stops dancing while the music is still being played, the couple will be ranked last in the dance. If this happens during the final round, the couple will be rank last in the dance.
- 11. Couples must be judged solely on their performance in the specific dance at the specific time.
- 12. For the attire:

#### Ladies:

- a. The area between the hip and the panty line, plus the back and breast must be covered. No see-through materials are allowed on these areas. No high-cut panties, tangas.
- b. When standing, the skirt should cover the panties completely.
- c. Any color, except flesh (skin color).
- d. Panties have to be black or the same color of the dress.

#### Men:

- a. Black or midnight blue trousers. Black or midnight blue or white shirt on top. Any other top is allowed if it is the color of the material of the lady's dress. The shirt or top has to be tucked ion. No sleeveless shirt or tops are allowed.
- b. The shirt can be open down to the end of the breastbone. See through materials can be used as the

- decoration but not as the basic material.
- Vest, jacket or bolero of the same color of trousers is optional.
- d. Tie, bow tie or scarf matching the trousers of the top is optional. If the scarf is worn, it has to be tied and tucked inside the shirt.
- e. Combinations of different materials of the same color are allowed.
- Short hairstyle is preferred.
- 12. Non-adherence to the attire rule would mean disqualification.
- 13. The decision of the judges is final.

- Props are allowed as long as they are handy and portable. Use of spray in any form or party pooper is not allowed during the performance.
- 8. Costumes should be decent and presentable.
- 9. Conductor/conductress is allowed.

1. Only one (1) female and one (1) male contestant per school.

- a. The contestant must be (height requirement) at least 5'1 for female and 5'4 for male and of good moral character.
- b. The contestant must be proficient in English and Filipino.
- The contestant must not have won any national or international title.
- The contestant must submit the following requirements to the search committee upon registration:
- Recent colored photograph, one (1) 5R sized close-up shot wearing school uniform
- Certification of Good Moral from the registrar
- Certification from the school that the participant (male/femsle) has no failing grade (75% below) last school year

#### Failure to submit these requirements will be disqualified.

- 2. The contestant is allowed to wear make-up, false eyelashes, and hair extension.
- 3. The contestant should attend briefing and all scheduled practices. Failure to do so is a ground for disqualification.
- 4. There are six categories:

I. Production Number

II. Festival Attire

III. Street Wear

IV. Formal Wear V. Interview

- 5. Top five will be chosen based on the cumulative scores of Production Number (25 percent), Festival Attire (25 percent), Street Wear (25 percent) and Formal Wear (25 percent).
- 6. Only the top five will undergo interview portion. The questions are related to the National congress theme.
- 7. Scoring is back to zero, in other words, the interview portion will be the basis for the selection of the major awards. The contestant is given a maximum of two (2) minutes to deliver his/her answer. One (1) point deduction is given (from every judge's total score) for every 10 seconds exceeding the time limit.

The contestant should deliver his/her answer in English.

- 4. The contestant is expected to perform during the production number.
