

1. Mechanics of the Contest:

1. The Art Drawing Contest is an On-the-Spot Contest.

- 2. All contestants shall provide themselves with the necessary materials and for the contest. (55 cms X 55 cms white cartolina to be cut and supplies ready before coming to the contest and watercolor, pastel or crayons), including drawing board or table and plastic chair. Pentel pens and colored pencils are not allowed.
- 3. Each contestant shall answer the official call of entries 30 minutes before official time for Number assignment and briefing on the subject to be drawn. Each contestant shall be given no more than 5 hours to work on his/her entry. No extension of time allowed. Contestant is requested to bring with them snacks and lunch.
- 4. Parents, Guardians and/or coaches are not allowed to enter the contest Area specifically provided by the organizer.
- 5. Cash Prizes and certificates will be awarded to the first 3 winners and to a number of consolation winners of the Art Drawing Contest.
- 6. All drawing entries shall become property of the YMCA of Negros Oriental.
- 7. The decision of the Board of Judges shall be final and un-appealable.
- 8. Registration fee of PhP150.00 inclusive of YMCA Membership Fee.
