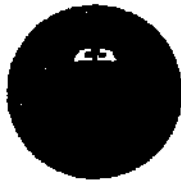

The DepEd NIR Youth Formation Summit

1. The Department of Education-Negros Island Region through the Education Support Services Division in partnership with the Schools Division of La Carlota City, Gaba-an Youth Lead, New Ground Events and PRISAAP will conduct the Nation of Heroes 4 : The DepEd-NIR Youth Formation Summit with the theme " Batang Bayani: Bahagi Ako ng Pagbabago", on October 21-23, 2016 at La Carlota City, Province of Negros Occidental.
2. The summit serves, in general , to develop and/or enhance the management and leadership knowledge, skills and attitudes of students through dynamic plenary sessions, interactive breakout sessions and enriched discussions, and to provide a venue for sharing best practices in youth formation programs.  - "Jam" (Kilos Kabataan)
 - Each team must only choose 1 of the 4 songs as suggested and must present within the duration of the song.
4. Malevolent actions or movements which are provocative in nature is strictly prohibited.
5. Pyro techniques during the contest presentation will not be considered and tolerated.
6. The dance should be a positive representation of youth empowerment and nationalism.
7. The following constitutes the criteria for judging:

NH 4 Vocal Duet Contest

Rules and Guidelines

(Elementary Level)

1. The song must be straight OPM in Filipino. The central theme of the chosen piece is Pagbabago.
2. Only bonafide students of any elementary school under the Negros Island Region is allowed to join in the competition.
3. The contestants should be male and female.
4. There should be two (2) voice parts.
5. Singing may be in acapella, or with live piano, guitar or minus one accompaniment.
6. Delivery is from 3 to 6 minutes.
7. The following constitutes the criteria for judging;

Diction	10%
Stage Presence	10%

GUIDELINES & MECHANICS

INTRODUCTION

The "Mr. & Ms. NH4 Ambassador/Ambassadors" is a wit, personality and beauty inside and out search among the participants of NH4 who will serve as ambassadors of the Youth Formation program in promoting youth advocacies in the region.

The candidates will compete in the following categories:

- Local Festival Costume
- School Uniform Competition
- Long Gown/Formal Attire Competition (Filipiniana)
- Question and Answer Portion

QUALIFICATION

The Search is open to single female and male students who meet the following minimum requirements:

- A bona fide NIR Grade 10 or 11 student.
- With pleasing personality

MECHANICS

Each candidate will compete in the following categories

Local Festival Costume – in the presentation of candidates during the Pageant Night, candidates will be in their Local Festival Costume. They will be rated according to its *Creative Design (50%)* and *Poise & Bearing (50%)*.

School Uniform Competition - in this category, candidates will be required to wear the school uniform of their respective schools to satisfy the criteria of *Personal Identity (30%)* and *Poise & Bearing (70%)*.

Long Gown/Formal Wear Competition - candidates must show proper poise and bearing while in their Long Gown/Formal Wear. They will be rated based on *Design and Fitting (50%)* and *Poise & Bearing (50%)*.

Question & Answer – Each candidate will be given one question to answer and the answer will be rated according to its relevance, substance, & value to the question given.

The candidates shall be judged on the following criteria:
