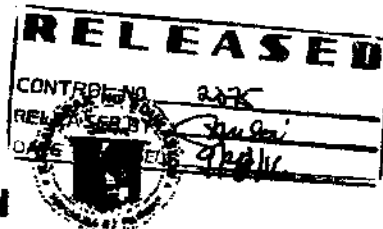

**Regional Seminar-Workshop on TV Script Writing and Broadcasting
for Campus Writers and Broadcasters in the Secondary Level**

TO: Schools Division Superintendents

1. Pursuant to the provisions of Republic Act 7079, also known as the Campus Journalism Act of 1991 and in preparation for the Regional and National Schools Press Conference, the Department of Education Negros Island Region, in coordination with the Regional School Paper Advisers Association, will conduct the *Regional Seminar-Workshop on TV Script Writing and Broadcasting for Campus Writers and Broadcasters in the Secondary Level (Grade 7-11)* on October 7-8, 2016 at Plaza Maria Suites Inn, Dumaguete City.
2. The Seminar-Workshop aims to:
 - a. demonstrate understanding on the basics of TV Scriptwriting and Broadcasting;
 - b. provide a venue for an enriching learning experience for campus writers and school paper advisers to be shared to their respective schools divisions;
 - c. promote responsible journalism and fair and ethical use of social media; and
 - d. enhance journalistic competence, in preparation for the Regional and National Schools Press Conferences.

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3. The activity shall include the following:
 - a. TV Script Writing and Broadcasting Basics
 - b. Video Research and Broadcast Script which includes Opening and Closing Billboards (OBB/CBB)
 - c. Field Reporting
4. All 16 school divisions are requested to send their English and Filipino Teams of seven (7) members plus one (1) school paper adviser for each team.
5. English and Filipino Education Program Supervisors and Officers of the Negros Island Regional School Paper Advisers Association are also requested to attend the seminar-workshop
6. The different teams must bring their own materials and equipment such as the following:
 - 6.1 Laptop with at least 10GB free space and a video editing program;
 - 6.2 Two (2) empty flash drives;
 - 6.3 Digital camera or phone camera, which is compatible with the laptop for the downloading of media;
 - 6.4 Compatible printer with ink; and
 - 6.5 Extension cord
7. Travelling and incidental expenses and a registration fee of Two Thousand Eight Hundred Pesos (P2,800.00), shall be charged to MOOE/local funds/Special Education Funds/ Campus Journalism funds or any available funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing procedures. The registration fee shall cover the cost of board and lodging, kits, including training materials, professional fees of trainers and facilitators, contingency and other related expenses incurred in the conduct of the training.
