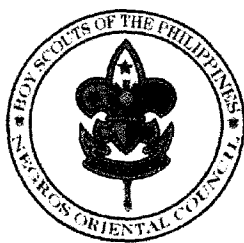

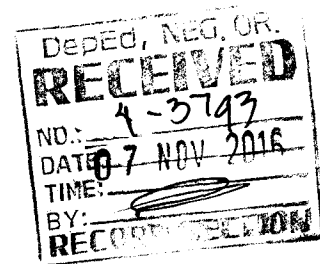


5. The Deadline for Submission of Nominees to the Negros Oriental Council will be on or before December 16, 2016. This includes documents and results of the evaluation.

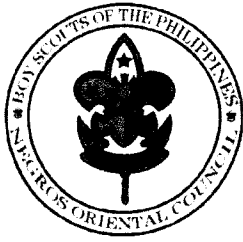
