

The Commission on Population recognizes the urgency to address risks and vulnerabilities being faced by Filipino youths today. The Young Adult Fertility Study (YAFS 4) conducted in 2013 revealed that the picture on sexual risk behaviors indicate a worsening trend. Further, the same study pointed out that the most significant person in the lives of an adolescent is a "friend, classmate, or in general the peer".

It is on this premise that POPCOM are enjoining our partners and the Department of Education to adopt a more proactive and youth -friendly strategy to reach out to young people, the Peer Approach. It is a strategy geared towards the creation of a safe physical and social environment for young people where they are given opportunity for participatory, innovative and experiential learning.

Thus, together with Ms Portia A. Francisco, Population Program Officer IV of the Provincial Health Office - Population Services Unit and POPCOM NIR would like to request the participation of 30 high school students to attend the live-in training on Adolescent Health and Development (AHD) Training for Peer Facilitators on August 3-5, 2016 at Hotel Essencia, Dumaguete City. Since we are an interim regional office, we have some budgetary constraints, we can only provide for the full board and lodging of the participants. Thus, may we request further the schools to provide for the transportation of participants in going to and from Dumaguete City.
