MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

ENJOINING SUPPORT FOR THE PHILIPPINE MENTAL HEALTH ASSOCIATION (PMHA)

1. The Philippine Mental Health Association (PMHA) Inc., through the Dumaguete City-Negros Oriental Chapter, request the assistance and support of DepEd offices and the public and private schools in carrying out its programs and projects through donations and membership fees. PMHA is a private, non-profit, non-sectarian organization dedicated to the promotion of mental health and the prevention of mental illness among our people, regardless of culture, socio-economic status, religion, sex, and age.
2. PMHA offers three-fold programs and services: primary, secondary, and tertiary. The primary program cover education and information services through seminar-workshops, lectures, film shows, community outreach and training programs, library services, student mental health clubs, etc. The secondary program covers out-patient social, psychological, and psychiatric services including diagnostic workups, neuro-psychiatric examinations, psychiatric consultations, family therapy and counselling referrals. The tertiary program provides rehabilitation services like vocational training and placement programs for the convalescing mentally ill.
3. Membership in the PMHA is open to all individuals and entities. The membership fees for non-voting members is PhP 10.00 for Associate Membership and PhP 5.00 for Junior Membership for high school students and elementary school pupils. Regular voting members pay as low as PhP 100.00.
4. DepEd teaching and non-teaching personnel and pupils and students of public and private schools are encouraged to support the PMHA. It is stressed, however, that membership fees and donations shall be *strictly voluntary*.
