The National Commission for Culture & the Arts (NCCA) has launched an integrated cultural development program called MUGNA (Towards a Sustained Cultural Development of Negros Island) which aims to establish a pro-active culture-based development that involves the communities at large. The project is being coordinated by the Negros Cultural Foundation, Inc., in partnership with the Dumaguete-based Youth Advocates Through Theatre Arts (YATTA).

The City of Dumaguete was chosen to be one of the six (6) pilot local government units in Negros Island.
