2nd ANNUAL CONFERENCE OF DEPED ENGINEERS/ ARCHITECTS

 The Education Facilities Division (EFD) conducts an annual conference of DepEd Engineers and Architects as a culminating activity every end of the year. The proposed activity is divided into two parts with the following objectives:

Part 1. Performance Review and Assessment (December 13-14, 2016) to be participated by ESSD chiefs of the Regional Offices, SGOD chiefs of the Division Offices, Regional and Division Engineers. DepED Projects Engineers and Selected staff from EFD. The objectives of this activity are as follows:

- review 2015 and 2016 accomplishments of different school buildings projects specifically the implementation of Basic Educational Facilities Funds (8FFF) and Public-Private School Infrastructure Project (PSIP I and II);
- share experiences in the implementation of the different projects particularly those that are being implemented by DPWH and determine appropriate courses of action to improve the management of projects as well as the partnership of the two agencies;
- update the participants on the approved programs and projects for 2017 and action plans for the implementation of the projects; and
- recognition of the Regions and Divisions' performance on the different programs and projects.

Part 2. Goal Planning and Teambuilding Activity (December 15, 2016). Participants to this activity are the Regional and Division Engineers, DepEd Project Engineers and Architects and selected EFD staff

- The proposed activity aims to achieve camaraderie among DepEd Engineers and Architects nationwide to strenghthen the bond and ensure alignment of each and everyone's priorities into achieving the goals, expectations and deliverables of the department in relation to the construction/repair/rehabilitation/maintenance of educational facilities.
- This activity is proposed to be held in Davao City, final venue will be announced later.
- 3. Travelling expenses of DepED Project Engineers, CO/EFD staff and other resource persons shall be charged against OSEC Funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
