The Neglected Tropical Diseases Program is the government's commitment to address soil-transmitted helminthiasis, schistosomiasis and lymphatic filariasis in the country. The establishment of an efficient and effective data management system and implementation of a standardized recording and reporting are essential tools to achieve "All for Health Towards Health for All" or the Universal Healthcare (UHC) strategic thrust. The aim is to "establish a modern information system that shall provide evidence for policy and program development, and support for immediate and effective provision of health care management at different levels in the health systems. With support from the World Health Organization (WHO), the Department of Health (DOH) developed the NTD MIS to standardize the data collection procedure for successful quality data management, improve and harmonize existing systems; develop tools to collect accurate and consistent data and generate reliable information. The NTD MIS is a combination of a web-based, mobile-based and short message service (SMS)-based system for data collection, processing, reporting and use of the information necessary for improving Mass Drug Administration (MDA) reports.


