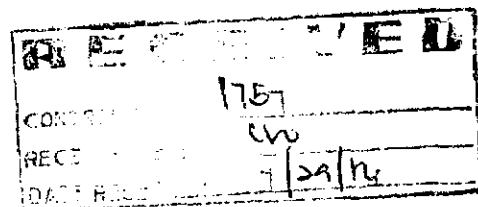

Dear Dr. Sadsad,

The immunization program has focused on the provision of free vaccines for infants since 1975. However, protection provided by some of these vaccines will decline over time and booster doses are required to ensure high levels of protection are maintained thus, it is important that health service providers take every available opportunity to deliver vaccines and start vaccination for the school children and adolescents enrolled.

The Department of Health (DOH), in collaboration with the Department of Education (DepEd) and Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG) will conduct a School-Based immunization in the whole month of August 2016. The objective of the activity is to immunize school children enrolled in Grade 1 and Grade 7 with Measles Containing Vaccine (MCV), Tetanus-Diphtheria (Td) and Measles Rubella (MR) as an integral immunization strategy towards elimination of measles, tetanus and the control of rubella and diphtheria.

In this context, may we respectfully inform your good office that the DOH-Regional Office VII will conduct **Consultative Meeting/Re-Orientation on Guidelines in the Implementation of School-Based Immunization** on 01 August 2016 (1:30 pm to 4:00 pm) at Plaza Maria Suites Inn, Dumaguete City, Negros Oriental.
