RULES AND GUIDELINES

1. Participants to this completion are the public elementary and secondary schools along the highway (within a 500 meter radius) in the Province of Negros Oriental.
2. A pre-evaluation will be made by a committee to determine whether the guidelines have been followed. Should the recommended school fail to meet the criteria, the school will be disqualified as a finalist.
3. Each city division is entitled to one entry while the Division of Negros Oriental is entitled to three (3) entries representing the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd Congressional Districts. All entries must be duly recommended by the respective Schools Division Superintendents Officers-In-Charge.

Entries should be faxed to the Provincial Tourism Office Tel. no. (035)2251825 and should be signed by the School Division Superintendent or by this choice chairman or representative.

4. Entries stating complete name of school address, name of school head and his/her contact numbers must be submitted to the Office of the Negros Oriental Tourism Council (NOTC) on or before September 9, 2016 at 5:00 pm.

5. Schools will be judged according to the following criteria.

A. Physical Facilities.....	35 pts.
B. Health Facilities.....	30 pts.
C. School Greening.....	25 p[ts.
D. Support System.....	10 pts.
E. Total.....	100 pts.

6. Certificates of Participation will be given to all participating schools.

7. Top three winners will be given plaques of recognition with the following cash prizes:

3. Third Place	Php 10,000.00
