A Seminar-Workshop on Writing Local History will be held on **September 9, 2016** at **Maxino College, Bagacay, Dumaguete City**, to which social science teachers and students and other interested persons are invited.

The seminar will be conducted by Mr. Emil B. Justimbaste who is the author of the following three books on local history: *Leon Kilat*; *Lukban: The Philippine-American Insurrection in Samar, 1899-1902*; and *Heroes, Brigands, Spies: The untold story of Leyte guerrillas during the Japanese Occupation, 1942-45*. His fourth book, *"Roots of Our Faith: A brief historical account of missionary work in Leyte from 1595 onward,"* will soon be off the press.

Before its publication as a book, *"Leon Kilat"* was published as a series of articles in *The Freeman*, a prestigious newspaper in Cebu. This work won the award as *"Best in Historical and Cultural Reporting"* given by the Philippine Press Institute and the Frederick Ebert Stiftung.

Participants will be given one book on a "first come, first to choose" and "while supply lasts" basis. However, the first 80 participants are guaranteed one book each.

The registration fee is P600 (cash only). Lunch will be served.


The seminar-workshop is at once important and relevant in line with the DepEd's desire that the academe will not only be consumers but also producers of knowledge. The need to write Philippine history in the perspective of the Filipino adds significance to the seminar workshop.


