3. The activity shall include the following:
 - a. Individual Writing (News, Feature, Editorial, Sports Writing, Cartooning, Science and Technology Writing, Copyreading and Headline Writing, Photojournalism.
 - b. TV Script Writing and Broadcasting
 - c. Radio Script Writing and Broadcasting
 - d. Collaborative Desktop Publishing
4. All participants are expected to bring laptops and be at the training venue on August 26, 2016 at 1 p.m. for the opening program. First meal to be served will be pm snacks of the first day and last meal will be lunch of last day.
5. Travelling and incidental expenses and a registration fee of Three Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (P3,500.00), shall be charged to MOOE/local funds/Special Education Funds/ Campus Journalism funds or any available funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing procedures. The registration fee shall cover the cost of board and lodging, kits, including training materials, professional fees of trainers and facilitators, contingency and other related expenses incurred in the conduct of the training.
