SUBJECT:

STRENGTHENING THE SYNCHRONIZED SCHOOL-WIDE READING

PROGRAM

- 1. The results of the Phil-IRI pretest and 2nd Quarter Oral Reading Verification test reveal a high number of non-readers. Thus, this Division strengthens the implementation of the SYNCHRONIZED SCHOOL-WIDE READING PROGRAM (SSWRP) in all schools. This supports the EVERY CHILD A READER PROGRAM (ECARP) in consonance to the thrust of the Department of Education (DepEd) to make every child a reader and a writer at his/her grade level.
- 2. District Supervisors/District In-Charge and School Administrators shall closely observe, monitor and supervise the program every afternoon at 1:00-1:30. Technical assistance to improve reading performance of the pupils/students shall be provided.
- 3. The teachers will prepare the weekly reading materials, games/activities, etc. using the weekly guide sheet to be utilized/ conducted during the SSWRP time which will be consolidated at the end of the school year. Reading Quadrants are required in the classroom.
- 4. Library time shall be included in the weekly Reading Program.
- 5. The elementary schools are reminded to administer the Phil-IRI post test using the 2012-2013 passages.
- 6. It is expected that at the end of the school year something has been done to improve the reading performance of the learners..
- 7. Immediate dissemination of and compliance with this Memorandum is enjoined.
