1. This is to announce the establishment of a DepEd Regional Office in the newly created Negros Island Region (NIR) pursuant to Section 1 of Executive Order 183 entitled *Creating a Negros Island and for Other Purposes* (copy enclosed).

Section 1. Negros Island Region. The Negros Island Region (NIR) is hereby created. The NIR shall be composed of the following provinces, including the cities, municipalities, and barangays comprising the provinces:

- a) Negros Oriental; and
- b) Negros Occidental.


2. Accordingly, the DepEd NIR shall consist of 16 schools divisions from Regions VI and VII, as follows:

3. As part of the new DepEd organizational structure, all DepEd offices/units concerned must involve and notify officially the DepEd NIR in their respective DepEd-wide programs/projects/activities.

4. For the information and guidance of all concerned, DepEd NIR is currently headed by **Director Gilbert T. Gadsad**, who has the authority, responsibility and accountability for the effective and efficient administration and supervision of the schools within the jurisdiction of the region, conformably with Section 3.2 of Rule III (Regional Director) of Republic Act No. 9155, known as the *Governance of Basic Education Act of 2001*.

5. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
