In the interest of growth and development of Arts Teachers primarily from schools with Special Program for the Arts (SPA) and Arts and Design Track, the Silliman University College of Performing and Visual Art and Silliman University Cultural Affairs in partnership with the Cultural Center of the Philippines, will hold the Sining sa Eskwela (SSE) Regional Workshop for Arts and Design Track from April 25-29, 2016 at the Luce Auditorium, Silliman Hall, Silliman University Dumaguete City.

The CCP has been implementing the training for the Department of Education's Special Program in the Arts (SPA) Pibt schools. It prepares teachers to develop artistic processes that would help them seek out and solve pedagogical issues by using critical thinking and innovate approaches for the K to 12 curriculum and the challenges that its forthcoming implementation presents. It also provides supplementary art and cultural instructional materials, and other assistance for the arts education program of the schools, including the indigenization of the curriculum.

To help defray costs for this workshop, a registration fee of Ph 3,500 will be collected before the program. This will also cover the lecture materials, module, t-shirt and certificate. For early registration before April 15, 2016 will get a discount of Ph 500.00.
