BUGLASAN FESTIVAL 2016


TO: **All District Supervisors** Secondary & Elementary School Heads/TICs All Others Concerned

- 1. Acting on the letter sent by Gov. Roel Ragay Degamo and pursuant to Provincial Board Resolution No. 15. S. 2002 stipulating the Annual Provincial Fiesta to be celebrated every October, this annual event will be set on October 14-23, 2016 anchored on the theme "Boosting Our Economy Through A United Citizenry." Hence, this office announces earnest support to the forthcoming Buglasan Festival 2016, a time when our province will showcase its accomplishments in tourism, culture and arts and will foster friendly competitions, praiseworthy presentations and warm fellowships.
- 2. Germane to this, all schools in the Metro Dumaguete Area (Dauin to Amlan) with school bands/ drum and bugle corps are hereby directed to join the Grand City Parade on October 15, 2016 and present a 2-hour Cultural Variety Show for the entire 10-day Buglasan season. The school may opt to choose where to stage their variety show out from 3 venues namely: Sidlakang Negros Village's "Padasig sa Buglasan" (from 6:00 PM to 8:00 PM) or at the Atrium @ Robinson's Place (6:00 PM to 8:00 PM) or at the Capitol Forecourt (from 6:00 PM to 8:00 PM).
- 3. It is encouraged that the schools which participated in the Grand City-Wide Parade last year as listed in the attached file must give their confirmation stating the specific category they like to participate in whether one is a competing school band or non-competing school band and express their intent to hold Cultural Variety Shows on Wednesday, August 3, 2016 to the Division Office thru Mrs. Jenith Corpis Cabajon, Division Social Mobilization Coordinator either through a text message or a call using her mobile phone no. 09058448183 or email her at jenith cabajon@deped.gov.ph.
- 4. In relevance to the theme on oneness, all participating schools are encouraged to work as a school community with the prime stakeholders who are the parents and the teachers to be part of the show other than the students involved in the spirit of hearty collaboration.
- 5. Moreover, schools which will be joining the said event must secure their own transportation and meals/ snack foods for their own participating school bands/ drums and bugle corps and their Cultural Variety Show team by mobilizing their own social mobilization coordinators to take initiatives or seek support from the LGU so as to realize this undertaking, an opportunity when DepEd being the agency that nurtures the learners' physical and musical prowess can showcase the talents and skills in a venue of significant tradition, culture and arts and a meaningful fellowship like Buglasan Festival 2016.


