- 1. The LAPG for Grade III and Grade VI National Achievement Test for School Year 2015-2016 shall be conducted on March 8 and March 10, 2016 respectively.
- 2. With our desire to increase the previous results of the above-mentioned tests, this office through the Curriculum Implementation Division is initiating the project called **OPLAN INAT**.
- 3. The **OPLAN iNAT** is a division initiated project spearheaded by the Curriculum Implementation Division whose main objective is to spur collaboration and support among Division Education Program Supervisors (DEPS)/Division Coordinators, Public Schools District Supervisors/District In Charge, public and private elementary and secondary school heads, teachers and other concerned stakeholders to zero the non-readers in schools and increase the results of the National Achievement Tests both for Grade III and Grade VI this school year.

- 5. The field is therefore informed to get ready always for the conduct of the Spot Tests by the Division Education Program Supervisors anytime from January and February, 2016.
