4. Wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.

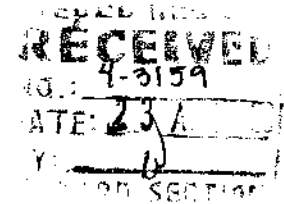

Dear Superintendent Cabrera:

A winning day ahead!

Starting nearly four decades ago, the MILO Marathon made its mark in the Philippines by being the first marathon to be considered a major national sports event. To this day, it remains the grandest, most prestigious running competition in the country with over 200,000 participants from all walks of life in key cities nationwide year on year.

MILO Marathon evolved into an even grander sporting event with its advocacy of giving shoes to school children. With the "Help Give Shoes" movement, a portion of every runner's registration fee is put into a collective pool, which is then doubled by MILO with its own monetary donation: Since its launch in 2010, the advocacy has helped give over 60,000 pairs of running shoes to kids who need them. This year, 600 pair of shoes shall be given to three (3) public schools in the Negros Oriental.

Now on its 40th edition, the **Provincial Government of Negros Oriental** through the Negros Oriental Sports Development Program (NOSDEP) have been awarded by the National Milo Marathon Organizer, after three (3) years, to host one of its qualifying races in thirteen (13) cities nationwide to be held in Dumaguete City. The only requirement to put the event in our Province **annually** is to hit the target of **10,000 runners participating** in all distances (3km, 5km, 10km and the 21km).

It is in this light that we request your support and to invite your students to register and run the **40th National MILO® Marathon Dumaguete City Qualifying Race on October 2, 2016.**

This race is an exceptional opportunity to showcase your school's best runners, raise your school colors and contribute to a bigger cause. The MILO® Marathon has various activities that you can participate in the **3-K Kiddie Run**, the **5-K Fun Run**, the **Biggest School Delegation Contest**, the **Interschool Running Team Competition**, and the **Cheer Dance Competition**.

In this connection, please allow our **NOSDEP - Milo Coordinators** to visit your schools and to explain the mechanics and how your school can avail the NOSDEP-MILO Schools Sports Project.
