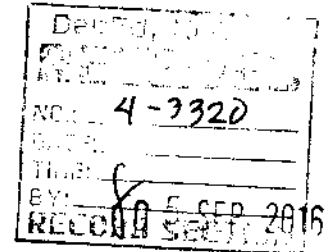

INTER-HIGH SCHOOL BUSINESS QUIZ BOWL

RULES AND GUIDELINES

**SEPTEMBER 15, 2016
8:00 A.M – 10:00 A.M, SSS Hall**

1. All contestants must be bona fide students of the participating school.
2. Contestants must be at the venue 30 minutes before the time of the competition.
3. The coverage for the Inter-High School Business Quiz Bowl will be economics, business math, and current events in the business world.
4. Two (2) participants for each participating school.
5. The quiz bowl consists of three sets: easy, moderate and difficult round.
6. Each answer will be scored one point (easy), two points (moderate) and three points (difficult).
7. Questions will only be read twice.
8. Contestants may start answering while the question is being read.
9. Time will be allotted to answer each question- 15 seconds for the easy round, 30 seconds for the moderate round and 60 seconds for the difficult round. The timer will ring the bell as soon as the time is up.
10. Contestants must raise their answer as soon as the bell rings.
11. Contestants must keep raising their answer boards until the quiz master says so.
12. In case of tie, a clincher round will be added. Each question in this round shall be answered within 60 seconds.
13. Protest will then be entertained by the technical committee before the announcement of winners.
14. The top three finalists will then be awarded as Champion, 1st Placer and 2nd Placer respectively.
15. Prizes will be in form of cash, medals, and certificates.
16. Any violation from the aforementioned rules and guidelines will ground for disqualification.
17. The decision of the technical committee is final and irrevocable.
