1. Anchored on DepEd Memorandum No. 139 S. 2016 stipulating the National Teachers' Month Celebration from September 5 - October 5, 2016 which is also the National Teachers' Day (NTD) and World Teachers' Day (WTD) as pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 242, Republic Act 10743 and UNESCO's designation of every 5th day of October as World Teachers' Day (WTD), you are hereby ordered to follow the synchronized programs, projects, and activities (SPPAs) and most particularly to observe the school-based celebrations along with the recitation of the Teachers' Prayer on October 5, 2016.
2. You are further required to post streamers with the required logo which is downloadable at www.deped.gov.ph/others to intensify awareness of the NTM, NTD, and WTD Celebrations.
3. Observing the FORMAT on Enclosure No. 3, all **DISTRICTS** must submit the ACTIVITIES lined-up highlighting these celebrations on September 13, 2016 to the **Division Office**, through the *Division Special Events Coordinator*, **for monitoring purposes**.
4. REPORTS on the activities conducted by the districts shall include clear photo with captions and a comprehensive documentation of the various activities implemented, must be thoroughly edited prior to submitting them on October 10, 2016 to the **Division Office** through **Mrs. Jenith Corpis Cabajon**, *Division Special Events Coordinator*.

**2016 NATIONAL TEACHERS' MONTH, NATIONAL TEACHERS' DAY
AND WORLD TEACHERS' DAY CELEBRATIONS**

1. The Department of Education (DepEd) will celebrate the **National Teachers' Month (NTM)** from September 5, 2016 to October 5, 2016 which is also the **National Teachers' Day (NTD)** and **World Teachers' Day (WTD)**. This is pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 242 entitled *Declaring the Period from September 5 to October 5 of Every Year as National Teachers' Month*, as well as Republic Act 10743 entitled *Declaring the 5th Day of October of Every Year as the National Teachers Day*, and to the designation of the World Teachers' Day every 5th of October by the United Nations Education and Cultural Organizations (UNESCO).
2. This year's NTM theme is *Guro Kabalikat sa Pagbabago*.
3. The Celebrations aim to:
 - a. honor those who are in the teaching profession;
 - b. acknowledge and give emphasis on the crucial role, loyal service and dedicated commitment of teachers in developing globally-minded citizens, nurturing families, strengthening communities, and building the nation;
 - c. revitalize the image of and respect for teaching as a vocation by increasing public awareness on the value of teachers in the Philippine society;
 - d. take the occasion as an opportunity in building the image of teaching as an attractive and fulfilling profession;
 - e. generate widespread support and assistance for teachers; and
 - f. express gratitude for the positive influences of teachers on Filipino learners.
4. All public and private elementary and secondary schools, including district, division and regional offices are enjoined to follow the synchronized programs, projects and activities (SPPAs). On October 5, school-based celebrations, including the recitation of *A Prayer for Teachers* or *Panalangin Para sa mga Guro* shall be observed.
5. The Central Office shall conduct the NTD and WTD Celebrations on **October 5, 2016** through a whole day program set at the Ateneo de Davao University, Jacinto St., Davao City.
6. All school heads, district supervisors, schools division superintendents (SDS), and regional directors (RDs) are enjoined to actively lead all activities for the NTM, NTD and WTD Celebrations.

7. All schools, school districts, schools division, regional and central offices are required to post streamers with the required logo to ensure that the public is aware of the NTM, NTD and WTD Celebrations. The digital files of the new streamer designs may be downloaded from www.deped.gov.ph/others.

8. In accordance with the SPPAs, all SDSs through the RDs are required to submit the following:

Particular	Deadline
a. Respective plans on NTD and WTD Celebrations, foremost of which is the conduct of their respective culminating activity;	On or before September 2, 2016
b. Names and contact numbers of their respective divisions and regional coordinators for the NTM, NTD and WTD Celebrations; and	
c. Reports on the activities conducted by the schools, school districts/divisions, and regions which shall include clear photos and a comprehensive documentation of the various activities implemented.	October 31, 2016

9. The regional offices shall consolidate these requirements and submit to the External Partnerships Service (EPS) through email address: spapo2012@gmail.com, for coordination and monitoring purposes.

10. All expenses relative to NTM, NTD and WTD Celebration shall be charged to local funds, subject to the usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

11. Compliance with the abovementioned requirements and the SPPAs for NTM, NTD and WTD shall be strictly monitored by the EPS.

PROCLAMATION NO. 242

DECLARING THE PERIOD FROM 05 SEPTEMBER TO 05 OCTOBER OF EVERY YEAR AS "NATIONAL TEACHERS' MONTH"

WHEREAS, the United Nations Education, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) designated 05 October of every year as "World Teachers' Day," which is a day to celebrate the central role that teachers play in guiding the children, youth and adults through the life-long learning process;

WHEREAS, there is a need to generate widespread awareness and support for World Teachers' Day here in the Philippines;

WHEREAS, it is essential to revitalize the image of teaching as a vocation by increasing public awareness on the value of teachers in Philippine society and national development;

WHEREAS, the occasion can be used to celebrate the unique role and service that teachers play in guiding families, strengthening communities, and building the nation;

WHEREAS, to contribute to the growth and development of the teaching profession in the country as well as to publicly express appreciation to teachers, both active and retired, a Teachers' Month Campaign (TMC) was conceived in July 2008 by the Metrobank Foundation, Inc. (MBFI), De la Salle Philippines (DSLPI), Philippine Business for Education (PBE), and Campaigns Social Response (CSR), with the special participation of the Department of Education (DepEd) and the support of key business institutions;

WHEREAS, owing to its success, the Campaign has generated more support from government, private companies, and major organizations in 2009 and 2010; and

WHEREAS, Presidential Proclamation No. 41 (s. 2010) declared the first Friday of September to 05 October 2010 as National Teachers' Month.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, BENIGNO S. AQUINO III, President of the Philippines, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby declare the period from 05 September to 05 October of every year as "**National Teachers' Month**."




In this regard, and as recommended by the TMC Steering Committee, I also endorse the recitation of the National Prayer for Teachers (**Annex A**) during the same period.

Accordingly, all concerned departments, agencies and instrumentalities of the national government, the various local government units, the private sector and the public at large are hereby enjoined to actively participate and support activities and programs for the celebration thereof.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the seal of the Republic of the Philippines to be affixed.

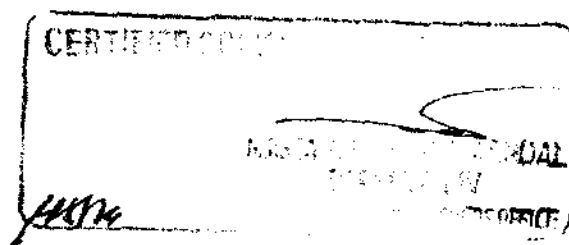

[REPUBLIC ACT NO. 10743]

AN ACT DECLARING THE FIFTH DAY OF OCTOBER OF EVERY YEAR AS THE NATIONAL TEACHERS' DAY

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the
Philippines in Congress assembled*

SECTION 1. *National Teachers' Day.* - The fifth day of
October of every year is hereby declared as the "National
Teachers' Day".


To ensure a meaningful observance of this special
working holiday, all heads of government agencies and
instrumentalities, including government-owned and -controlled
corporations especially those that are directly dealing with the
teachers, including local government units, and employers in
the private sector, shall encourage and afford sufficient time
and opportunities for their employees to engage and participate
in any activity conducted within the premises of their offices


or establishments in celebration of the "National Teachers' Day".

SEC. 2. *Lead Agency.* - Pursuant to the observance of the National Teachers' Day, the annual program of activities shall be prepared and implemented with the Department of Education as the lead agency.


SEC. 3. *Effectivity.* - This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its complete publication in the *Official Gazette* or in at least two (2) newspapers of general circulation, whichever comes earlier.


