CORRIGENDUM TO DM # 46,S.2016 RE: 2016 DIVISION LANGUAGE ARTS SHOW AND CLARIFICATORY MATTERS ON SOME CONTEST GUIDELINES

1. This office informs the field about some clarification and corrigendum on the following contest guidelines:

A. Interpretasyon ng Larawan

Ang larawan na bibigyang-kahulugan at salaysay ng kalahok ay hinggil sa tema ng Language Arts Show sa halip na tungkol sa Kalikasan

B. Song Composition and Interpretation (English and Filipino for Senior High School)

Scores of contestants from Lyrics and Content Competition, and Interpretation Competition will be added and divided by two to get the average score. Average score of each contestant will be the bases in determining the winner. In the division level, the composed song of the winning contestant and the actual interpretation will be judged accordingly following this clarificatory guidelines.

Two or three accompanying instrumentalists are allowed during the contest.

C. Speech Choir

- 1. The only contest piece is the poem entitled Initially Yours, CHANGE written by Gracia Rodel B. Deloria.
- 2. There should only be 20-25 participants/students.
- 3. Each group needs to deliver the contest piece within ten minutes.
- 4. Any form of humming may be done but singing and adding of line is not allowed.

5. The winner shall be determined using the following criteria:

Delivery 40% (Quality of voice, fluency, pronunciation, blending,

and harmony)

Interpretation 20% (Manner the piece is internalized and presented)

Stage Presence 20% (Stage Poise, eye contact, and audience impact)

Costume and sound effects 10% (attire and sound

effects are related to the concept)

Mastery of the piece 10%

6. Any violation of the above mentioned rules will mean disqualification.

7. The decision of the board of Judges is final and irrevocable.
