

### 1st NEGROS ISLAND REGION STATISTICS QUIZ Contest Design and Procedures

### A. REGISTRATION PROCEDURES

- The contest is open to all Grade 11 students enrolled in a duly recognized senior high school.
   This will be held on <u>October 28, 206</u>, 1:00PM at Central Philippines State University Main Campus, Barangay Camingawan, Kabankalan City, Negros Occidental.
- 2. All contestants must be officially endorsed by the school head and attested by the school registrar that the contestant has just enrolled in or has just completed a semester in the current school semester (S.Y. 2016-2017) as Grade 11 senior high school student of the institution that he/she represents. One coach is allowed per participating school. At most, a school may send two (2) contestants. Deadline of submission of entries will be on or before October 24, 2016. Entries may be sent either email (psanir.rsso@gmail.com) or printed copy using the attached Information Sheet.
- Contestant must not be a relative within the third degree of consanguinity/affinity with any member of the working committee and PSA-NIR employees.
- 4. All qualified contestants and their coaches must register on the day of the contest prior to the official start of the contest program. Only contestants who are properly registered will be allowed to compete. Only coaches who are properly registered will be allowed to make darifications or raise questions during the contest proper.
- The Steering Committee may create sub-committees such as the board of judges, timekeepers, examiners and proctor, quizmasters etc. as may be needed during the contest date.

### B. CONTEST DESIGN

- Contestants may use non-programmable scientific calculators during the contest proper. These should be properly registered with the secretariat prior to the start of the contest program.
- Contestants will be issued official identification numbers for reference purposes.
- The contest consists of three sequential round the 1<sup>st</sup> Round (Easy Round), 2<sup>nd</sup> Round (Moderate Round) and Final Round (Difficult Round).
- In the first round, contestants will be asked to answer twenty (20) easy questions. Each question for this round is worth 1 point.

- In the second round, contestants will be asked to answer fifteen (15) moderate questions. Every question in this round is worth 2 points.
- 6. The final round will be composed of ten (10) difficult questions worth 3 points each.
- Scoring shall be cumulative. The scores in the first, second and final round will be added to determine the top three winners.
- In all rounds, questions will be read by the quizmaster. Where computers and multimedia projectors are available, the questions will be projected on a screen, at the same time that these are being read.
- Contestants will either be given sheets of papers on which to write their answers, or flash cards containing the answer choices A, B, C, and D.
- 10. A trial run will be conducted before the start of Round 1.
- 11. The guizmaster will read each guestion, four choices, and time limit for the guestion.
- 12. The official timekeeper will signal the end of time allotted for answering a specific question. The quizmaster will announce "Time is up", after which, all the contestants should immediately raise their answer sheets or flash cards.
- 13. The quizmaster will announce the correct answer (also shown on screen), and proceed to read the answer of each contestants. Examiners will tally the scores. Official examiners of the region will tally the scores at the end of each round.
- 14. In case of tie qualifying for the first three highest rank, a tie-breaking questions will be administered to the involved contestants to determine the cut.
- 15. Questions covered in this contest are the concepts, theories and applications of statistics including current issues and Philippines laws on statistics.

#### C. QUESTIONS ON PROCEEDINGS, QUESTIONS, ANSWERS AND SCORES

- Any clarification and/or question with regard to the proceedings, contest questions, answers and scores of contestants may be raised only by the contestants and their official registered coach.
- Clarifications and questions on contest proceedings should be raised prior to the start of the contest proper.
- Clarifications and questions on contest questions, answers and contestants scores should be raised during the round which they pertain.
- A Steering Committee or the duly designated SQ Board of Judges shall be the sole arbiter for questions and issues raised and their decision shall be deemed final and irrevocable.

### D. PRIZES AND AWARDS

 The top three winners shall receive a trophy, certificate of recognition and the following cash prizes:

> 1st Place - ₱3,000.00 2nd Place - ₱2,000.00 3rd Place - ₱1,000.00

Likewise, the coaches and the school where winners are enrolled shall receive Certificates of Recognition.
