Target Participants:

EPS, School Heads, Teachers-in-Charge, Head Teachers and Admin Staff of DepEd

Overview:

This training will allow the participant to understand his or her strengths and weaknesses, allowing him/her to interact meaningfully with other leaders, individuals and group.
