2016 REGIONAL POPULATION QUIZ (POPQUIZ) Contest Guidelines, Rules and Mechanics

- 1 The content of questions will be based on the Population Education Core Messages/Krs Concepts as follows
 - · Family Life and Responsible Parenthood
 - · Gender and Development
 - Population and Reproductive Health
 - · Population, Environment, Resources and Sustainable Development
- Review materials for the POPQUIZ will be provided by DepED/POPCOM.
- 3. Contestants will be provided with white board pen and whiteboard
- 4 Finglish and Filipino will be used as the official languages in the conduct of the quiz
- 3 There will be a total of twenty (20) questions to be given, 6 of which are "easy". I are "average", and 7 are "difficult" questions.
- 6. Points for every correct answer will be given as follows

One (1) points - for an "easy greenen
 Two (2) points - for an "average" question
 Three (3) points - for a "difficult" question

- 7 The quizmaster will read each question twice. Countdown will start after the question has been read the socond time.
- We Contestants will be given a nyesimum of thirty (W) seconds to answer questions that require computation. Other questions will only be suven ten (10) to littleen (15) seconds or as indicated by the test formulations.
- 9. Should a contestant wish to change an answer that heishe has written down this answer should be crased and the new answer should be clearly written clearly. A contestant is allowed to change his her answer within the time allotment for a particular question. For multiple choice questions, the answer should be written in CAPITAL letter.
- 10. When the quizmaster says STOP or TIME IS UP, contestants must raise their whiteboards to the audience and to the Board of Judges for 5 seconds or until such time that the Proctor have verified or confirmed the answer
- 11. A regional champion will be proclaimed based on a constance scoring system
- 12. All nes will be broken by a nebreaker question from the "difficult" category
- 13 The following procedure will be observed in case of a protest or inquiry during the actual quiz proceedings
 - (3) Only the official coach of the contestant is allowed to raise a protest or inquiry at the earliest appropriate time during the contest.
 - 13.2 The protest or inquiry will be addressed orally to the Chairman of the Board of Judges who will recognize the protest or inquiry.
 - 13.3 The Chairman of the Board of Judges will announce decisions resulting from the protest or inquiry at the earliest appropriate time during the confest.

Regional On-The-Spot Jingle Writing and Singing Contest Contest Guidelines, Rules Mechanics and Criteria for Judging

Rules and Guidelines

1. Participants shall be provided with sheets of paper and pen-

2 The specific theme, mechanics and the criteria for judging the contest will be announced a few minutes before the start of the contest.

3 For the patrs, there should be no markings on the surface of the paper. Name and the name of the school should be printed at the back of the contest piece.

4 The contest is only good for two (2) hours. After which, the contest piece shall be performed in front of the judges and the audience.

5. The decision of the Board of Judges is final

Mechanics

- I The piece shall be an original composition. It must be written in English
- 2 The piece shall be 4 lines per stanza and should not exceed 4 stanzas
- 3 The contestants shall be given two (2) hours to compose and practice their piece
- 4 The piece must be submitted to the Hoard of Judges before the performance
- 5 The confestants are given 3-4 number to perform. Thereafter, a dement of 1 point per 5 seconds in excess of the 4 minutes maximum performance.
