

USAID has contracted Social Impact to evaluate the impact and cost-effectiveness of the Basa Pilipinas program on student reading comprehension.

This evaluation involves collecting data from schools in Region I and Region VII. Social Impact and their data collection partner, TNS Philippines, will soon be providing your office with a list of schools that will participate in the data collection. This list of participating schools was randomly selected from among the schools that use the target mother tongue as the medium of teaching and learning: Ilokano for Region I and Sinigbuanong Binisaya for Region VII. These schools are the same ones previously visited in October 2015.

During practice testing and data collection, the trained data collection team will first meet with and interview the School Head. The team will then randomly select a section from Grade I, Grade 2, and Grade 3. Teachers for these sections will be invited to participate in an interview and a classroom observation, and randomly selected students from these sections will be invited to participate in short learning assessments.

The School Head and teacher interviews and observation are not school or teacher evaluations, but are instead intended to gather information about the learning environment of students participating in the study. Students will be individually assessed by trained assessors using assessment tools designed to measure early grade literacy and numeracy skills.
