•CONDITIONS TO QUALIFY IN THE SCREENING OF APPLICANTS TO OUR FREE BOARDING HIGH SCHOOL:

- HE/SHE MUST BE BETWEEN 12 14 YEARS OLO ANO HAVE NOT enrolled or STUDIEO HIGH SCHOOL.
- HE/SHE MUST HAVE COMPLETED HIS/HER ELEMENTARY STUDIES OR PRESENTLY ENROLLEO IN GRACE 6.
- MUST COME FROM POOR FAMILIES WITH MONTHLY INCOME OF PHP 5, 000.00 OR BELOW.
- NO BROTHERS AND SISTERS STUDYING IN ANY OF OUR SCHOOLS ANO/OR A GRAOUATE OF OUR SCHOOLS- SISTERS OF MARY SCHOOL.
- FOR ELEMENTARY GRADUATES, HE/SHE MUST PRESENT HIS/HER ORIGINAL GRADE VI CARD DURING THE QUALIFYING TEST.
- FOR THOSE WHO ARE PRESENTLY IN GRADE VI, THEY MUST SECURE CERTIFICATION FROM
 THE SCHOOL PRINCIPAL INDICATING THAT THEY ARE CURRENTLY ENROLLED AND HAVE A
 GENERAL AVERAGE OF 83 AND ABOVE ON THEIR LATEST GRADING PERIOD.
- THEY MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY ONE OF THEIR PARENTS OR GUARDIAN ON THE OAY OF THE EXAMINATION.
- THEY MUST PRESENT THEIR BIRTH CERTIFICATE WITH 1X1 ID PICTURE (2 COPIES)
 AND BAPTISMAL CERTIFICATE (PHOTOCOPY).

•DURING THE EXAMINATION, THE APPLICANTS MUST BRING A PEN AND WHAT IS ASKED IN CONDITIONS 5-8, WHICHEVER CATEGORY HE/SHE BELONGS.
