

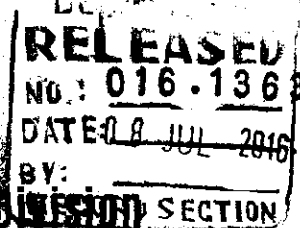

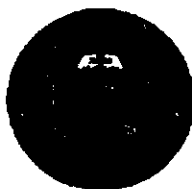

Non-communicable diseases (NCDs) are considered a major public health problem in the Philippines. They account for 60% of total deaths which contributes to universal disease burden annually. It is projected that if no action is done in the present, these rates would increase to as high as 73% to total deaths by 2020 (WHO, 2005).
