Greetings from VOICE Philippines. Allow us to extend our warmest congratulations on your designation as the first DepEd Regional Director for the new Negros Island Region.

VOICE is a non-sectarian, PCNC-accredited (for Philippine Council for NGO Certification) national NGO whose advocacy is to inculcate God-based values to the younger generation. In line with the Constitution (the Preamble's "imploring the aid of Almighty God", Art. II Sect. 13, Art. IV Sect. 3.2) and the Moral Recovery Program of the government, VOICE for more than a decade now has collaborated with DepEd in teaching supplemental Godly values instruction classes (VICs) at no cost to the government, in 17 regions and 74 of 81 provinces nationwide.

We are writing this letter to officially request your kind permission that the trained volunteer teachers from our community partners – specifically those from Bayawan City among many others in the island - be allowed to continue teaching VICs in the new Region. The VOICE values program and curriculum have been officially adopted by the Bayawan City LGU for their Bayawanihan values formation program.

Values education is a very urgent and unquestionable need for young Filipinos. VOICE's God-based values program supplements DepEd's Edukasyon sa Pagpapapakatao. It strictly teaches values only and not religion for VOICE recognizes that our Constitution differentiates faith in God - which the State promotes for its citizens - from religion which the State maintains benevolent neutrality. Children will best choose good from bad and do what is right instead of what is wrong if spurred by faith in God. God believing Filipinos - regardless of religion - will make for good citizens.

Lastly, the VOICE curriculum and program had been evaluated by several DepEd regional and division officials with favorable findings and recommendations.
